1. What commercial applications are rugs and carpeting best suited to?

The benefits include improved acoustics (i.e. reduction in echo and foot traffic noise), increased comfort and safety through slip-resistant cushioning, aesthetic appeal, and a capacity to soften spaces.

3. What is the material composite of Axminster carpet?

80% wool 20% nylon

4. What is the purpose of VOC Emissions Testing in the context of rugs and carpeting?

VOC Emissions Testing measures the levels of volatile organic compounds present in rugs and carpeting. In this way, it indicates their likely effect on indoor air quality.

5. What is the purpose of colourfastness testing in the context of rugs and carpeting?

Colourfastness testing evaluates resistance to fading and staining; and indicates the longevity of the product in question.
