1. Name the residential applications of aluminium battens and lining

3. Outline the maintenance requirements of aluminium battens and lining.

Products of this type do not require regular painting, staining, or sealing, they have a long lifespan and, once installed their maintenance is very low. They require washdown with only water or a mild detergent.

4. Given that aluminium production is a carbon intensive process, does it follow that products made of this material are inherently unsustainable? If not, why not?

Though aluminium production is carbon intensive, the material is also 100% recyclable, extremely durable and abundantly available. Therefore, products of this type that include recycled materials and are appropriately sourced can be considered sustainable.

5. What is meant by the term lifecycle assessment in this context?

Lifecycle assessment is a measurement of the environmental impacts of a product or service across its life cycle, from raw material extraction to end-of-life.

6. What is meant by the term Light Reflectance Value (LRV)?

Measured on a scale from zero to 100, Light Reflectance Value quantifies the visible and usable light that is reflected from a surface.
